It also focuses on women's empowerment with livelihoods, cultural activities and awareness programs. As of now, we have initiated many programmes in the rural sector like education, health, HIV, child labour, training farmers on business modules etc. As Nelson Mandela quotes, "Education is the most powerful weapon to change the world." We are trying to do constructive work for students who are not able to get the opportunity to access an education due to economic constraints, social barriers, migration, single parents, orphanhood, etc. Supporting students who are having difficulty in learning and growing, as well as building their future. We are not only trying to create a safe environment with shelter, food, clothes, health and education; but also engage them in a disciplined way of life, where there will be physical and mental growth for an individual. Creating values for life, skill development and empowering them to stand on their own are the alternative objectives of this initiative. We are very keen on being in every district of India, identifying such kids and bringing them all together. Kids from the age group of 6 to 14 years will be admitted if they come from an underprivileged, migrated or orphan background.

# Our Activities

## *Aids Awareness Program*



On 01.04.2020 our team organized a program to create awareness on Aids in St. Mary's high school PK Halli. All students and staff of the school were present and a Mathrubhoomi team.

## *Agriculture Development Awareness*



We kept the intention of that to help farmers in villages. Our team organized a program for former students on 17-01- 2021 at Kambatrahalli village. In the program Mr.B Devendragouda (Taluk Agricultural officer Harapanahlli), Mr.T Rajendraj, Mr.Basappa and 10 members of the former were to be part of

the program. Our team explained about Savayav Krushi and to adopt scientific agriculture at their farm, gave orientation on dairying and at the end of the program all farmers were to attend the program.

## Our Activities

### *Child Labour Awareness*

On 20th March 2021, the Outreach team had organized Mathrubhoomi to the parents of the families who didn't have access to basic facilities and whose children were never enrolled in schools. This meeting was also organized for school dropouts and child labour. The team visited the families, discussed and convinced the parents to admit their kids to schools.



# ***Ration Kit Distribution:***

During the ongoing pandemic and lockdown, we distributed 50 dry ration kits and mask to the families from Mathrubhoomi. Each consists of 10kg of Rice, 1 litre of oil, 1kg of Dahl, 1kg of salt, & 2kg of Sugar. As the majority of the parents were struggling in this pandemic in Tumkur dist.. # ***Awareness on Child Rights***



On 06-08-2020 4 at V S K University Ballari. We organized an awareness program on Child Labor, Child Rights and Child Protection. Mr.Ishangouda, Mr.Ganesh and lecturers were presented along with MSW college students. Mr.Ganesh spoke about how to protect from children abuse and to encourage children to grab their rights and Mr.Ishangouda spoke about protection of children

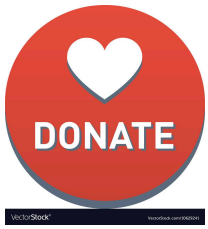
